Mr. Dejan Štancer was the initiator and founder of the Kazakh-Slovenian Business Club (KSBC), together with entrepreneurs from Slovenia and Kazakhstan. After the KSBC was established, back in year 2013 he worked as the Secretary General of the KSBC. He became a President of the KSBC in November, 2016. Prior to that, Mr. Štancer was as a registered lobbyist in the Republic of Slovenia and at the institutions of European Union. Mr. Štancer has many years of International business experience and rich entrepreneurial experience, as he also worked as an advisor to various subjects of commercial law in the European Union and also globally. In June 2017, the KSBC under the leadership of Mr. Štancer organized one of the most successful Slovenian and International economic delegation to Kazakhstan – a delegation of Smart Cities and Regions solution providers. In May 2018, Mr. Štancer has signed an agreement with the National Company of the Republic of Kazakhstan »Kazakh Invest«, according to which the KSBC has become an Official regional representative office of Kazakh Invest in region of Central and South-Eastern Europe. Today the KSBC is one of the largest business clubs in the region, with offices from Switzerland, Austria, and Slovenia, but also in the region of Central Asia. Today he mainly follows the idea of so called »Two regions initiative«, which aims to connect more closely the two large regions - Central and South-East of Europe with Central Asia. The purpose of the initiative is to establish strong business and investment potential, to strengthen the national economies, but also to create new working places, as well as to create new added value. The idea of two regions also provides for two HUBs, with Kazakhstan playing the main role, since the idea envisages the main HUB of Central Asia in Astana, the capital of Kazakhstan.
